## **Funding Guidelines**

## Projects must support the following goals:

- To nurture faith and spiritual growth
- To foster supportive communities
- To develop leadership skills
- To work towards justice and peace

## General Guidelines:

- 1. Preference will be given to applications which maximize the potential of touching the lives of many women.
- 2. Funding is for one year only per project. After the completion of the first year and submission of the report (by May 1), you may apply for a second year of funding. The same project will not be funded for more than 2 years with the *exception* of quilting projects. Please note: Funding a project for one year does not guarantee that the project will be funded the next year. Alternate sources of funding should be sought.
- 3. The same group can apply for funding for different projects the same year.
- 4. If there are other sources of funding available for your project, explore those before applying to WOFF. Please indicate in the application form if other sources of funding have been/are being explored.
- 5. Projects that support or work with CLWR are eligible for funding.
- 6. Projects associated with CLAY will be considered on an individual basis.
- 7. Wages will not be funded.
- 8. Tuition costs will only be funded in exceptional circumstances, e.g. non-profit, church related organization for a specific course/workshop.
- 9. Funding for mission projects will be covered in some circumstances. Travel incurred for a mission project will not be covered.
- 10. Projects for individual personal growth are not eligible for funding.
