Frequently Asked Questions

When will there be details on the 2022 ELCIC National Convention?

The planning team is hard at work finalizing an agenda and other details for convention. We hope to have more information for you in the coming weeks. When will registration open for the 2022 ELCIC National Convention?

Delegate registration will be open shortly. All delegates will be emailed a copy of the registration form directly.

What if I'm not familiar with how an online meeting happens?

An orientation for all delegates will be taking place prior to this year's online convention. Agenda items for orientation will not only include an overview of proceedings but also information on the technology and how to do things like speak to a motion and voting.

When will the Bulletin of Reports be available?

As per our Administrative Bylaws, the Bulletin of Reports is required to be available to all delegates at least forty-five days before convention.

What is the deadline for submitting petitions to National Convention?

Petitions from synods and congregations are required to be submitted to the secretary of the church at least ninety days prior to the convention for referral to the Committee of Reference and Counsel, and for inclusion in the Bulletin of Reports.

How will delegates be determined for the special 2023 ELCIC National Convention.

Individuals who have been selected as delegates for the online 2022 ELCIC Convention will also be delegates to the special 2023 ELCIC National Convention. We'll share more information about this in-person gathering as it becomes available.

Can I choose whether I prefer to attend this year's online convention or next year's in-person convention?

You have been elected/appointed to attend this year's convention, which will take place online. All delegates who attend this year's convention are automatically designated as the delegates for the 2023 special convention. If you are unable to attend the 2023 special convention, your synod can appoint someone in your place.

What if I'm young enough to be in the 16-20 age range this year but won't be next year?

If you are a delegate to the 2022 ELCIC National Convention (online), you are automatically designated as a delegate to the 2023 special convention.
